## FORMER CHIEFS PLAYER KNIVED TO DEATH

*A 26 year old player born in Kroonstad, Free State, Jeffrey Ntuka was stabbed to death at a local tavern on the 21st January 2012 during an argument with his drinking mates. He was a former Bafana Bafana, Kaizer Chiefs and Supersport United player.*

One of his prime career highlights was when he spent six months in the books of Chelsea in the U.K. His mistress known as Morwesi Temeki was with him at the time of the stabbing. She is expecting his child which will

never know its father. She claimed that, "those who killed Ntuka are jealous of his successes and that they were dating."

His wife, Phumzile said her husband left home on Thursday with his friends. Mrs Ntuka added that she is very devastated by the death of her husband.

His brother Thabo confirmed that they went to identify the blood soaked body at the mortuary. The Maokeng Police Spokesperson Langa Maselela said that a case of murder had been opened and police were on the hunt for the suspected murderers.

Ntuka joined the Transnet School of Excellent in 2001, and he spent his time playing for KVC Westerlo in Belgium. He played in the U23 national squad and in 2005 he was introduced to Bafana Bafana by Stuart Baxter.
