Cassim Park Hall in Msukaligwa was voted as the suitable venue to host the multitude of Methodist Church followers of Msukaligwa Circuit and all the Christians across the province that came to accompany the messiah to the cross.

The young and passionate man Rev Gadini took the 2012 Passover in storm as thousands of Methodist Church gathered to get the message of the year. Prophet Matthew was decided to open the feast though Chapter 27 verse 27 to 44 to share the sentiment of the journey of this year's Passover.

The Reverend acknowledged the people that were in the church that his key word of the day should be the cross. However he continued acknowledging them that why there was the cross.

On the seven that was spoken by Jesus Christ Mr Masuku was the first soldier on the cross to revive the words of the prophet Luke who emphasised the cross on chapter 23; 34 Mr Masuku had to highlight the words of the Christ when he said “Baba bathethelele ngoba abakwazi abakwenzayo “FATHER FORGIVE THEM, THEY DO KNOW WHAT ARE THEY DOING”.

Mama Twala carried the responsibility emphasise the three crosses that were at that place. And also explain the words from the person that was crucified next to him, when he said that can you be with me when you go to the paradise.

Mrs Nkonyane led the words from Prophet John on the chapter 19 verse 26-7. When Jesus saw his mother Maria Magdalene said here is your son and he replied here is your mother, actually he knew that everything was accomplished.

Mrs Vilakazi had to explain the time that Jesus was on the cross from 9 o'clock in the morning as he was bleeding on the cross, but he had strength to say (eloi-eloi) at 12o'clock midday God created darkness suddenly the temple was divided into two parts.

Ubaba D Msibi come so thirst on the podium to share with other Christians in the church, that Jesus was thirst at that time according to Mark 15; 28, his thirstiness was not physical but also the transition of the people in the world, he was crucified by the people who were his friends, and Mr Msibi said our enemies is our friends no one would come from unknown place to kill you.

Mr Hlangu spoke about the accomplishment of a journey of Jesus Christ after all his deed in the world, as the blind people were able see free; the disabilities are able to work free.



The questions do you know yourself on this year's Passover? Rev Mngomezulu brought the seven word of the day that was said by Jesus on Luke 23; 46 when he was upon to die, he said that my father i commit my spirit to you and he died.
