

OPERATION WINTER WARM IN CAROLINA

With the bitterly cold weather experienced last week, the needy residents of Carolina welcomed receiving blankets, gloves and hats to warm them . A total of 315 blankets, 200 hats and 200 pairs of gloves were distributed throughout the community.

Some of the recipients included the two old age home which are SAVF Ons Eie Outehuis and Vukuzenzele Old Age Home in Silobela. 70 blankets were distributed to pensioners who visit Caropark every Thursday morning to collect tokens of charity from the community.

All needy learners at Zinekeleni Secondary, Sobhuza Public School, Violet Jiyane Middle School and Ezenzeleni Primary School also recived blankets. 50 learners from Ezenzeleni also received gloves and hats.

Smiles were also put on the faces of our pre-schoolers from PT Phatha Crèche, Thembeluthu Crèche and Joy Christian School. Needy learners from both the Islamic institutions at Caropark and Silobela also received blankets, gloves and hats. Children from the Siyaqubekha Orphan and Vulnerable Centre were also recipients.

The principal of one of the schools commented that many of these learners have received a blanket for the first time in their lives, and we will never understand the joy it would bring not only to them but to their other siblings whom they will share it with.

This initiative was undertaken by the local muslim community of Carolina in partnership with Al-Imdaad , an international humanitarian aid organization.
