The Mpumalanga Province Premier Hon DD Mabuza brought up to the community the 2012/13 mandate for Mpumalanga Province.

In his five year plan, he articulated the vision and and laid down the strategic plan on delivery to the Province.

The manifesto is due to start before the end of the month (May 2012) said the proud Premier. The memorandum of understanding to the portfolio committee will be a vehicle of the legislature to accomplish the vision of the project.

Some of the key areas to embark on are poverty alleviation, Job Creation, building of houses for the old, child-headed houses, and persons with disability as well as to provide kids with school uniforms. Elderly citizens and securing ID documents for the elderly, food parcels to the poor and a high pass rate at schools was the spotlight on his primary goal, including socio-economy and infrastructure development.

The Premier aims to build relationships with the media at every legislative meeting because his philosophy is that the media is power, the biggest stakeholder in the world to inform the community about any development.

HonourableMabuza finalised by appealing to the house to approve the R158 103 000.00(one hundred and fifty eight million one hundred and three thousands rands) budget for The Office of the Premier.

Theft power cables, burning of the councillor houses and municipalities property by protestors in the community was rebuked. This is to be banished by those concerned because people will come back and ask for the same property that they have been burning during the demonstrations. He added that this causes millions of Rands in damages to the province and creates delay of infrastructure development.

The premier alluded to the fact that the shortage of water in the province was one of the major concerns of his office.

The government has committed to accelerate the process on speed delivery of infrastructure in a short space of time and he added that his office did not have intervals when it comes to development and infrastructure in the province.
