BATAU FC DID IT AGAIN

Batau are feeling very confident that they will win the Mpumalanga region of the Vodacom League

After a convincing 6-0 victory against Sekhukhune, Batau are feeling very confident that they will win the Mpumalanga region of the Vodacom League and there by achieving their objective of competing in the national regional play off in Polokwane come July.

According to the latest log position Batau have conceded only 9 goals against, and scored 73 for, leaving them with a goal difference of 64 and a point's accumulation of 66. SAFA must still rectify an issue regarding a disciplinary committee hearing involving a match versus Thabo All stars, where by this team

used a player that was red carded the week before and did not sit out the mandatory two match suspension. The match ended 1-1, but Batau are of the opinion that they will be rewarded with maximum points once the DC is finalised. Looking forward to a very tough encounter at Bushbuckridge on Wednesday the 16th of May against seventh placed FC Benfica and will hope to capitalise on their poor defensive record, conceding 44 goals in 26 matches.

“I will use the squad rotation system to give some none regular starters game time as we have a very tough match away on Saturday versus 15th

placed Lynnville All Stars who are fighting for survival” SAFA's website indicates that Batau have two games outstanding which is incorrect. These two matches were scheduled in the first round as home games for Batau but both teams did not arrive for the fixture and a 2-0 score line plus a maximum 6 points was awarded to Batau in terms of the rules and regulations. Injury concerns to Mathebula, Sokhweba and Matsimaya, other wise we will have a full compliment of players to select our team. Till next week, go Batau.
